Picking up at Farm verses Drop points

At Farm - Tote bags will be given; produce will be arranged according to Share Type. On occasion we will have a "Your Choice" of different items (first come first serve basis). Allow time for packing and selecting.

At Drop points - Shares will be pre-packed in food grade boxes marked with the members' names on the outside of the box. Due to the expense of the boxes please return yours the next pick-up day.

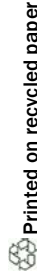

How our Programs Works

We encourage members/shareholders to begin by choosing share size and type for the harvest. Select day and pick up location for your weekly produce. If you or your designated party is unable to pick up your share, it will be donated to a local shelter/food bank the following day. If you need to make other arrangements, please notify us by email 48 hours in advance.

Summer/Fall Harvest – 18 weeks, end of June to October

Our crop consists of over 200 varieties; mostly heirloom and unique produce known for its flavor and appearance. Standard Market members pick up the more common vegetables and herbs; while our epicureans receive everything we grow including edible flowers.

When in season you can expect to receive melons grown on our farm.
